## **TUITION AND FEES**

Registration and full camp payment must be received no later than one day prior to the beginning date of the chosen camp. Payments received after this date, add \$25.00. The student may lose their spot in the dance camp to another student who is on the waiting list if payment has not been paid one day in advance of the chosen camp.

## **DROP OFF AND PICK UP TIMES**

Before care is from 8:00 to 9:30am. If you drop your child off for camp before 8:50am you will be charged for before care. This also goes for after care which begins promptly at 2:30pm. There will be a 15 minute grace period after 2:30pm. Please call the studio if you will be any later than 2:45pm and are not signed up for after care. You will be charged for after care after 2:45pm. After care will end promptly at 5:30pm. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

## **Commonly asked camp questions**

1. Q - What will I need to bring to camp every day?  
A – Comfortable dance attire (any color leotard and ballet or jazz shoes), a sleeping bag to lay on when we watch the movie, a packed lunch, and a water bottle. (PLEASE MARK YOUR CHILD’S NAME ON EVERY ITEM THEY BRING TO CAMP)
2. Q - Will there be a place to keep my campers lunch cold?  
A –Yes, we have a huge cooler in the hallway to keep your child’s lunch cold.
3. Q - Will I need to provide a daily snack for my camper?  
A –No, snack is provided by Revelle Academy every day.
4. Q - Will my child be a part of the show even if she doesn’t want to audition for a lead role?  
A - All campers will have a part in the show in some way. There will be auditions for most “musical theatre” camps for lead roles, but there will also be other ways for your child to be involved such as supporting roles, roles with one line, group numbers and even dancing, comedy or acting parts. Even though there will be a show, there will not be auditions for Teeny Tiny Camps.
5. Q - How long will the show last and where will it be performed?  
A – Each camp will produce a different show ranging anywhere from 15-30 minutes depending on the theme and total number of campers. The actual location of the show is TBA.
6. Q - Can friends and family come to the end of camp performance?  
A – Of course! We invite you to bring anyone who would like to see your shining star!
7. Q - What if I think my child deserved a role other than what they received?  
A – Please understand that there will be an audition for all the lead roles and EVERY student will participate in the show. As directors we consider every aspect during an audition from stage presence, comedic timing, musicality, ability to sing on key, confidence, improvisation skills, knowledge of the show’s material, etc. Please understand that we want to give each child their moment to shine and believe that every part, no matter how small, is important to the overall success of the show!
8. Q - Will my child have some down time during the camp to relax?  
A – Yes, we will be having movie time for 30 minutes to an hour each day of camp after lunch to let stomachs settle and cool down from all the dance activity of the day. Remember this is a dance camp and the students will be dancing, playing theater games and rehearsing during the rest of camp in order to put on a show at the end of the camp. We have found in the past that this small amount of down time is a great way to rejuvenate and keep camp enthusiasm high.
9. Q – Are boys going to attend the camp?  
A - We love to have boys participate in our camps. We have lead boy roles to fill in many of our camps.
10. Q -What is an average day at camp like?  
A - Depending on the age range of the camps the schedules will vary with each theme. We will be playing theater games, dancing, learning acrobatics, singing, acting, having craft time, playing games, watching a movie and much, much more!
